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SUMMARY: To coach and administrate the sideline cheer program at Genesee High School.

QUALIFICATIONS:

1. Minimum: NFICEP or ASEP certification. Preferred: Bachelor's degree and Idaho teaching certificate.
2. An understanding that coaching varsity athletics involves many other responsibilities and duties beyond practice, competition and sideline cheer.
3. Ability to work in conjunction with other staff members, parents, and community persons.
4. Spirit coaching experience which clearly demonstrates evidence of ability to coach male and female athletes.
5. Ability to be flexible in meeting the needs of athletes and the school community.
6. Ability to recognize areas of athletic potential, as well as demonstrated abilities.
7. Knowledge of principles related to motivation of athletes from varying ability levels and learning styles.
8. Ability to develop and implement an evaluation design to assess student development.
9. Expectations of high performance for both athletes and self.
10. Understanding of school and district athletic philosophy.
11. Knowledge of athletic training and basic first aid.
12. Must successfully pass a State Department of Education criminal background check.

MAJOR JOB RESPONSIBILITIES:

1. Plan and direct spirit practices, sideline cheer from the beginning of the fall sports season to the end of the winter sports season.
2. Communicate actively and effectively with volunteer coaches, athletes, teachers, parents, administration and media and maintain a professional rapport with athletes.
3. Supervise set-up, locker room, and storage areas before, during, and after practice and competition when applicable.
4. Follow all district policies and procedures, IHSA rules and regulations and any other applicable state and federal laws.
5. Work under the direction of the Principal and Athletic Director.

TOOLS/EQUIPMENT USED ON THE JOB: Mats, pompons, megaphone, audio-visual equipment, and athletic training supplies.

PHYSICAL DEMANDS: Standing, walking, sitting, frequently lifting 10-15 lb. and sometimes 25 lb., occasionally pushing or pulling 50 lb., stooping, kneeling, crouching, twisting and bending, frequent reaching, occasional driving. Environmental conditions working outside most of the time, often cold and wet.

1. One year appointment. To be evaluated annually.
