High School Advanced Opportunities & Dual Credit Info Session for parents of current 9th-11th Grade Students Tuesday, May 16th

This is an information session for any parents who would like to refresher about the Advanced Opportunities funds available to students to pay for:

- summer online courses
- overload online courses taken during the school year
- dual college credit fees for dual credit courses

I will also share information about the General Education Matriculation (core) college requirements shared by all Idaho public colleges and universities which can be taken during high school, which of these General Ed courses can be taken from Genesee teachers during high school, as well as online dual credit options.

This information will be covered with the high school students during their classes here at school before we leave for the summer, so they do not need to attend this session. **The presentation will be in the school multi-purpose room on Tuesday, May 16th from 7:00-8:00pm.** I hope you will make every effort to attend as you can often learn as much or more from the questions and answers that will arise during the discussion related to this presentation.

Four-Year Plan Workshop on Thursday, May 18th for Eighth Graders & Parents

The State Department of Education's Idaho Administrative Code for Public Schools requires that all students have a Four Year Plan developed and placed in their school file by the end of the eighth grade year. This plan is to be the cooperative effort of the student and their parent(s), with the assistance of school personnel. The primary objective of this plan is to develop academic course choices for the four years of high school. Another desired outcome of this plan is to help the student perceive the connection between their high school curriculum choices and the impact it will have on their career and/or educational options after high school.

We will be conducting a Four Year Plan Workshop for eighth graders and their parents here at the school Thursday, May 18th. The workshop will run from 7:00-8:00p.m. and will be held in the multi-purpose room. students are required to have a four year academic plan for high school by the end of the eighth grade year please make every effort to attend this event.

College Planning Resource for Parents

Earlier this year I attended a workshop in Moscow on helping students explore college options. Peggy Jenkins who heads up Palouse Pathways ran the workshop. During the program Peggy mentioned what she considers her favorite resource she has found to date for helping parents prepare to help their sons and daughters look for colleges that will fit their child's needs and --hopefully--the family's financial situation. Since it is never too early to start thinking about college options (and in particular how to pay for it!), I wanted to pass this info along to you.
